Committee Reports:

Fundraising: Christy Stiff reported: Christy will remain in the position of the fundraising/sponsorships coordinator for the 2018-19 school year.

Dine-to-Donate update: Culver's profit: \$643.43

The next dine-to-donate event will probably be the Papa John's pizza truck. We are looking into making this a regular event.

The Popcorn sale netted a \$1,538 profit. \$1,121 went to the students' accounts, with \$417 going toward the band.

The candle sale was very similar in profits when compared to the popcorn sale. All of the proceeds from the candle sale went to the students' accounts.

Mattress Fundraiser: Approx. 94 people showed for the parent presentation. The band earned \$250 for meeting the quota of parents present at the parent meeting. **The mattress sale is Sunday, April 15th.** 60% of all proceeds from the mattress sale will go to the band. Students can earn a \$25 referral for their student account when a mattress is purchased and their name is given for the referral.

Sponsorships: Seals Funeral Home will again be a sponsor for the 2018-19 school year. The Optimist Club will be a sponsor again as well. The Optimist Club would like to continue its tradition of having the band/guard students help with its annual Ball Day on first Saturday in June, as well as having the MV Jazz Band play at its Santa Breakfast in December. Also beginning with the 2018-19 school year, students will have the opportunity to earn 10% profit when they bring in a monetary sponsorship to the band.

Communications: Susan Dunn reported: Sam Mathis will be the new Communications person for the 2018-19 school year. Susan will help Sam with the transition. Susan will be creating another yearbook that covers this school year; 2017-18. She is also still putting the final touches together for the next newsletter.

DCI- Amanda Fronek reported: MV will host the drum corps Phantom Regiment for a day in June, as well as a few days in August- Aug. 7 - 11. ** We may need a few parent volunteers to help with a few things for the August visit. Because MV will host the drum corps, the MV band will earn 3 scholarships to the Music For All Band Camp @ Ball State this Summer; this is the camp that the drum majors attend every Summer. The band will also earn 100 tickets for the DCI prelims for marching band/guard students & 2 directors to attend. The band will also earn a cash amount for hosting the drum corps.
