Approval of last month's minutes: Approval
had already been made of minutes for
December meeting, no board meeting held in
January.

Old Business:

North Quarter Update: Cheryl Campbell.
The Gold Country Casino conference room
cost is \$250 for half of what we used. We were
able to use the entire room due to no other
activities being scheduled that day. The entire
room usually cost \$500. The North Quarter
President has requested our guild sponsor the
2019 "meet the instructor" meeting. We may
want to consider the cost before agreeing to this
request. This decision was tabled till later in the
year.

given at a local school. We can see if there are
children interested.

She is going to ask if there are members willing
to provide one on one instruction and some will

need to be willing to provide their personal
sewing machine. Class will be only half a day
for 5 days probably in July.

postpone until later in the year.

balances are good.

she is looking for a white glove coordinator.

list of items we have for the boutique, it
included a list of items that would be good to
have. We need many more items to make this
boutique successful.

Chairperson's Reports:

on the instructions for this month's block.

Properties: Judy Hohman reports some repairs are needed on a machine and she needs to check out the printer

Membership: It was decided to have the cover in color again with pic of our quilt.

Community Service: Jan Owens reported that she still needs to set up a radio interview about our service award we received last year.

Other Reports: Sharon Helton has invited Debbie to clean sewing machines again at our June retreat.

Sharon also report she has been in communication with the magazine called Primitive Quilts and Projects. They are going to do a complete spread on our quilt show and include a picture of our opportunity quilt for this year.
