



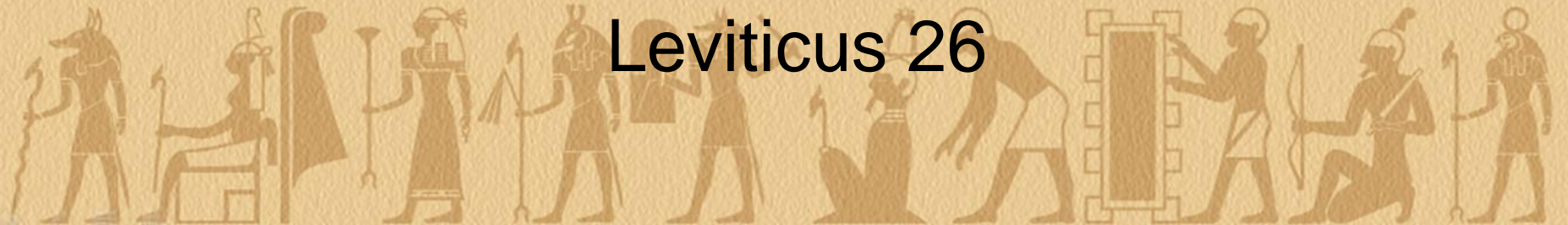

The Worship Ordination

The Worship Set in Order:

Death of Nadab and Abihu Lev. 10:1-20

- Nadab and Abihu take censers, put fire in, add incense, and offer strange fire
- Not commanded by the Lord
- Fire comes out from presence of Lord and consumes them



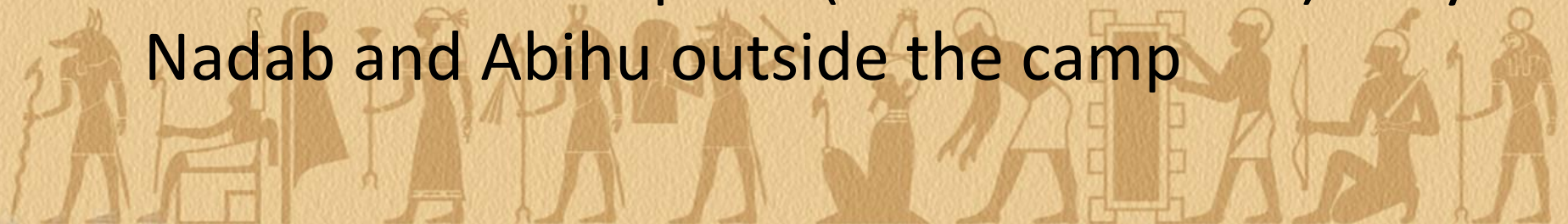


The Worship Ordination

The Worship Set in Order:

Death of Nadab and Abihu (cont.)

- Moses to Aaron – This is what the Lord was talking about; that He would be holy and honored before all the people
- Aaron remains silent
- Mishael and Elzaphan (Aaron's cousins) bury Nadab and Abihu outside the camp





The Worship Ordination

The Worship Set in Order:

Death of Nadab and Abihu (cont.)

- Aaron, Eleazar and Ithamar were not to show grief, but continue the work at the tabernacle
- Moses warns them not to drink wine/alcohol but remain holy and able to teach
- Priests reminded of allowable food from the sacrifice offerings



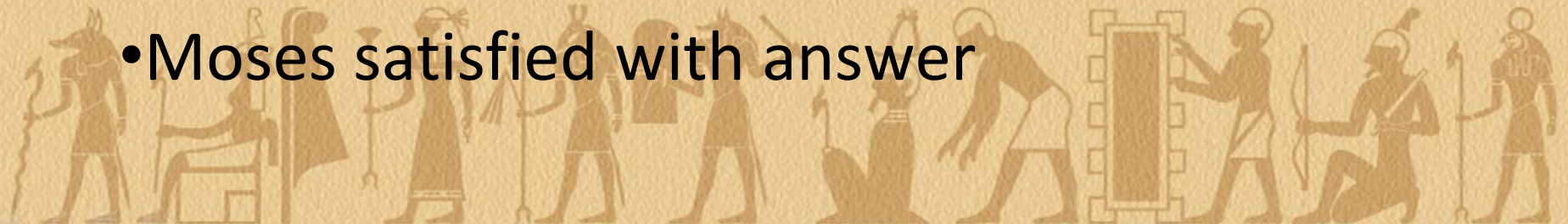


The Worship Ordination

The Worship Set in Order:

Death of Nadab and Abihu (cont.)

- Moses inquires about the goat of sin offering, that it had all been burned and not eaten by Eleazar and Ithamar
- Aaron - Because of the death of his other sons the Lord would not have been pleased
- Moses satisfied with answer





The Worship Ordination

The Passover is Observed:

Passover celebrated Num. 9:1-5

- Tabernacle set up the 1st day of 1st month in 2nd year
- Priests consecrated 8 days
- Princes make offerings same 8 days + 4 more
- God reminds Moses to have Israelites celebrate Passover at twilight of 14th day





The Worship Ordination

The Passover is Observed:

Problem of the unclean Num. 9:6-14

- Some could not partake Passover because they had handled the dead and were unclean
- Ask Moses and Aaron should they eat Passover or skip it?
- Moses doesn't know, so inquires of the Lord





The Worship Ordination

The Passover is Observed:

Problem of the unclean (cont.)

- Lord's answer:
 - An Israelite unclean from dead or away on trip may eat Passover one month later
 - If above person fails to observe Passover, he is to be cut off
 - An alien may celebrate Passover in accordance with all rules and regulations

Observances, Feasts, etc

Sacrifices for the congregation Num 28:1-29,40

- Daily: 2 lambs
- Sabbath day: 2 additional lambs
- New moons: 11 additional animals
- Passover: 18 additional animals on all 8 days
- Feast of weeks: 11 additional animals
- Day of Atonement: 10 additional animals





Observances, Feasts, etc

☐ Sacrifices for the congregation Num 28:1-29,40

☐ Feast of Ingathering/Tabernacles (8 days)

- ☐ 1st 30 extra animals
- ☐ 2nd 29 extra animals
- ☐ 3rd 28 extra animals
- ☐ 4th 27 extra animals
- ☐ 5th 26 extra animals
- ☐ 6th 25 extra animals
- ☐ 7th 24 extra animals
- ☐ 8th 10 extra animals





Observances, Feasts, etc

- Sabbath day Lev 23:1-3
- New moons Num 28:11-15
- Beginning of religious calendar
 - Passover and Feast of Unleavened Bread Lev 23:4-14
 - Feast of Weeks/Feast of Fifty
- End of religious calendar
 - Feast of Trumpets
 - Day of Atonement
 - Feast of Tabernacles

Numbered and Organized

Soldiers Numbered & Organized :

- Counting the soldiers Num 1:1-46
 - 1 month after tabernacle set up
 - Every male, above 20, able to war
 - Moses & Aaron to count; one prince from each tribe to assist





Numbered and Organized

Soldiers Numbered & Organized :

- Counting the soldiers (cont.) Num 1:1-46

– Results:

How many tribes? Why?

Largest tribe was?

Tribe not counted was?

Total was?





Numbered and Organized

Soldiers Numbered & Organized :

- Arrangement of camps Num 2:1-34
 - Around tabernacle with standard for tribe and banner for family
 - Marching orders for moving out also given





Numbered and Organized

Soldiers Numbered & Organized :

- Arrangement of camps (cont.)
 - East side:
 - Judah, Issachar, Zebulun
 - “camp of Judah”
 - 186,400
 - First to move out





Numbered and Organized

Soldiers Numbered & Organized :

- Arrangement of camps (cont.)
 - South side:
 - Reuben, Simeon, Gad
 - “camp of Reuben”
 - 151,450
 - After the camp of Judah





Numbered and Organized

Soldiers Numbered & Organized :

- Arrangement of camps (cont.)
 - West side:
 - Ephraim, Manasseh, Benjamin
 - “camp of Ephraim”
 - 108,100
 - After the Tabernacle/Levites





Numbered and Organized

Soldiers Numbered & Organized :

- Arrangement of camps (cont.)
 - North side:
 - Dan, Asher, Naphtali
 - “camp of Dan”
 - 157,600
 - Brought up the rear





Numbered and Organized

Levites Numbered & Organized :

- Not in soldier census Num 1:47-53
 - Appointed to be in charge of tabernacle and furnishings
 - Take down and set up
 - Anyone else – put to death





Numbered and Organized

Levites Numbered & Organized :

- Levites presented to Aaron Num 3:5-10
 - Presented to Aaron by Moses
 - To do work of the tabernacle
 - Take care of furnishings
 - Fulfill obligations of Israelites
 - Given to High Priest; but could not serve as priests





Numbered and Organized

Levites Numbered & Organized :

- Levites as redeemer Num 3:11-20,39-51
 - Taken by Lord instead of first-born males
 - To be counted, 1 mo. and older
 - 22,000





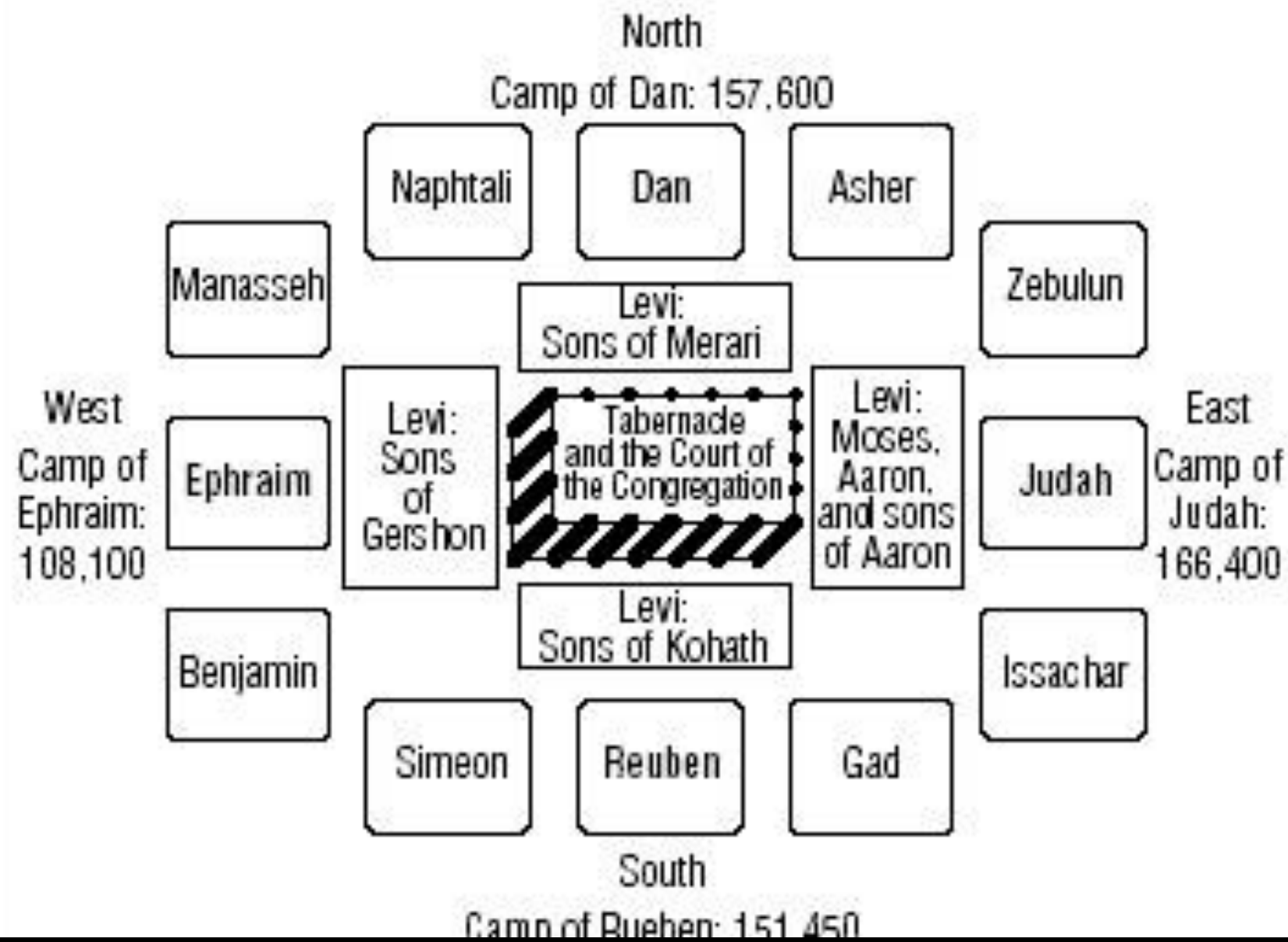
Numbered and Organized

Levites Numbered & Organized :

- Levites as redeemer (cont.)
 - Now Israelites of same age counted and names listed
 - 22,273
 - Levites taken instead of firstborn; firstlings of livestock also
 - 273 extra, 5 shekels each for Aaron



The Order of Encampment





Numbered and Organized

Levites Numbered & Organized :

- Organized and duties given (cont.)
 - Counted again by clans for duties
 - Transport tabernacle 30-50 yrs. old
 - Other duties 25-50 yrs. old





Numbered and Organized

Levites Numbered & Organized :

- Organized and duties given (cont.)
 - Gershonites 3:21-26; 4:21-28; 7:7
 - Curtains and hangings of tabernacle and court
 - 2 wagons, 4 oxen
 - Supervised by Ithamar

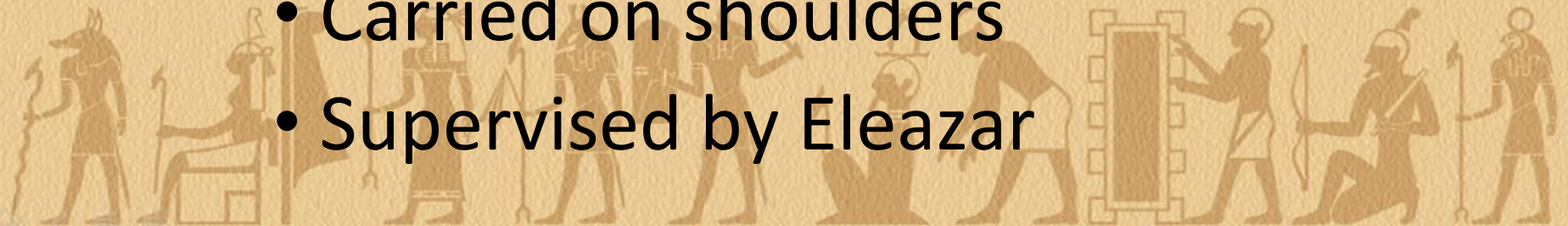




Numbered and Organized

Levites Numbered & Organized :

- Organized and duties given (cont.)
 - Kohathites 3:27-32; 4:1-20; 7:9
 - Care and portage of furniture; ark, altar of incense, lampstand, table of shewbread, altar of burnt offering
 - Carried on shoulders
 - Supervised by Eleazar

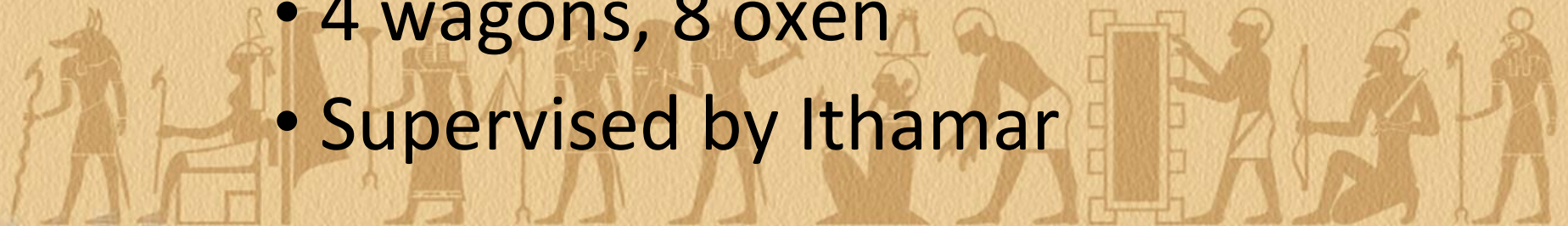




Numbered and Organized

Levites Numbered & Organized :

- Organized and duties given (cont.)
 - Merarites 3:33-37; 4:29-33, 42-45; 7:8
 - Boards, sockets, stakes, cords, pillars, and posts of court
 - 4 wagons, 8 oxen
 - Supervised by Ithamar







Numbered and Organized

Time to Leave Mt. Sinai Num 10:11-13

– 20th day of 2nd month in 2nd year

– Cloud was taken up from the
tabernacle

– Children of Israel set out from the
Wilderness of Sinai
