Scholarships are awarded on a yearly basis. You are encouraged to apply each year, whether or not you previously have been awarded a scholarship.

Eligibility Requirements: To be eligible for one of these scholarships, you must:

1. Be a resident of Georgetown, Maine.
2. Have been accepted or wait listed* at an accredited school for further advanced education - trade school, college, or university.

Scholarship Requirements: To apply for one of these scholarships, you must:

1. Obtain instructions and an application form from your high school guidance counselor, from the Georgetown Working League Scholarship Committee (address below), or from the Georgetown Town Office.
2. **The completed application form must be handwritten and signed in ink.**
3. Gather all supplemental materials: application, essay, transcript, and a copy of acceptance or wait list letter*.
4. Submit the application and supplemental materials **in one envelope** postmarked no later than **April 30th** to:

6. **If you fail to enclose the required information, and/or submit it late, your application will be automatically disqualified.**
