Here are the facts

- 1) The ONLY difference between Orinda's "public" and "private" streets is who pays to repair and maintain them.
- 2) You are not alone – 20% of Orinda lives on "private" streets.
- 3) Over the next 20 years you will pay about \$20,000 to repair and maintain the public residential streets you seldom if ever use.
- 4) Even so, the City Council just voted to bar you from receiving ANY funding from your taxes, unlike your neighbors living on "public" cul-de-sacs and streets.
- 5) Likewise, though the city receives approximately \$350,000 annually from sanitation services (which you pay) for damage done to Orinda's streets by their heavy trucks, that money goes ONLY to maintain "public" streets.
