5. FLUTES, CLARINETS, ALTO SAXOPHONES, TRUMPETS-Instruments go underneath the bus. If underneath storage is unavailable, your instrument will go on the bus with you
6. We will be dressing at the show site. Attire Requirements:
  - Marching shoes, long black athletic socks (not dress socks), black shirt, black athletic shorts

**Suggestions for Parents:**

1. Arrive early to get a good seat! It is recommended to be seated as high and centered in the stands as possible
2. It is always a good idea to sit in a group
3. Please do not shout names of individual students. Treat the band as a whole unit.
4. Be positive about all performing groups. You never know who is hearing your conversation.
5. If traveling in your vehicle with the band, do not merge into the bus/truck convoy. Please follow behind. Spectator parking will be in a different location than bus/truck parking.
6. Plan ahead with your travel time. These shows run like clockwork. If the schedule says we perform at 4:26 PM...expect us to enter the field at 4:26PM!!!

8. **Spectator Parking:** Off Hal Sharpe Road, parking lots northwest and west of football stadium

*What is the difference between “Scholastic Class” and “Open Class”?*

*SCHOLASTIC CLASS caps the size of a marching band. This allows bands of a similar size to compete against each other regardless of the resources at each band’s disposal (# of band directors, # of staff, financial support from the district, budgets, etc).*

*OPEN CLASS is determined by school enrollment of the previous school year. Caps do not exist on band size. This attempts to even out the resources at each band's disposal (# of band directors, # of staff, financial support from the district, budgets, etc).*

*Mt. Vernon High School is a SCHOLASTIC CLASS A and OPEN CLASS B school.*
