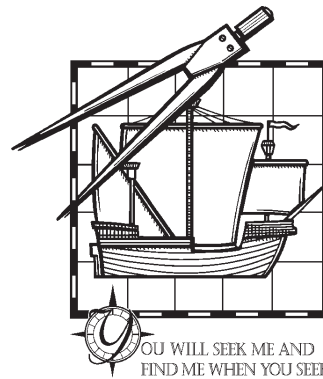

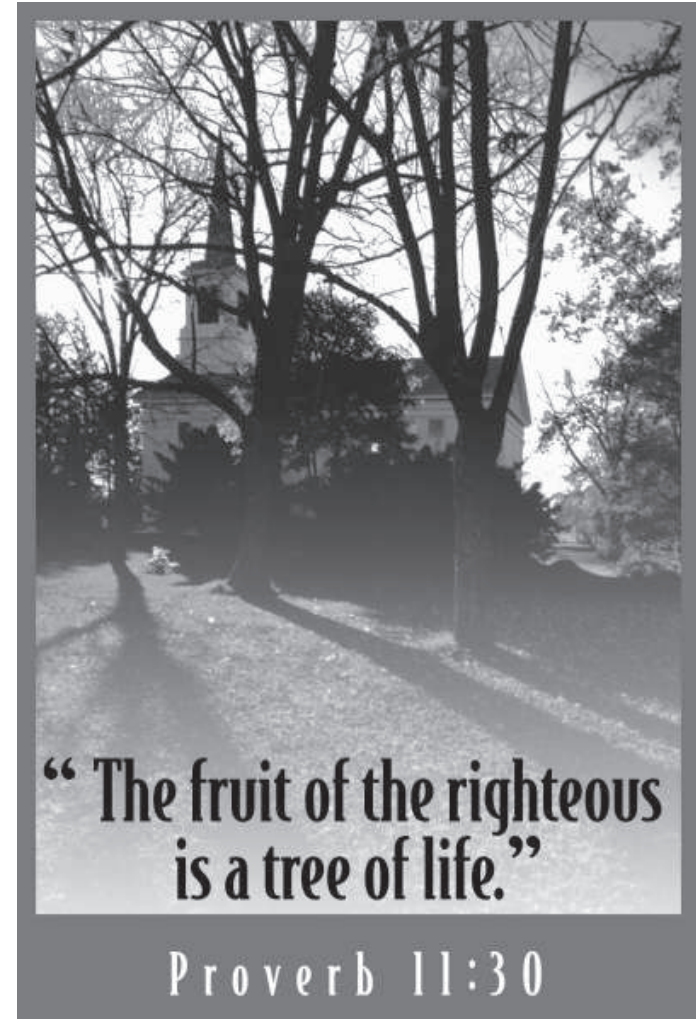

All these services and more are provided at no charge, only donations. With Dion's death, CLCI does not have the luxury of his salary being provided by the GTBN. Now, to employ a new director will require more funds than we have ever amassed! In order for the ministries of Shepherd's Inn and Calvary House to effectively continue, churches and individuals need to come to our aid. My goal is for one hundred churches of our network to give \$100.00 per month and one hundred individuals to give \$50.00 per month. With this kind of funding, CLCI could at least begin to find its feet AD: "after Dion!" Won't you help? Please! God bless you for all you do for our Lord!
