Date of the Exodus

- Two main suggestions as to date:
 - 15th Century BC (c. 1447 BC)
 - 13th Century BC (c. 1290 BC)
- Two biblical texts involved:
 - 1 Kings 6:1
 - Judges 11:26

1 Kings 6:1

Solomon's 4th year = c. 967 BC
Less 480 years 480 years
Date of Exodus= c. 1447 BC

Judges 11:26

Time of Jephthah c. 1100 BC
Less 300 years 300
Less 7 years of conquest 7
Date of Occupation c. 1407 BC
Period of wandering 40 years
Date of Exodus c. 1447 BC

Exodus

- The name comes from the LXX, and means "the way out."
- It records the beginning of the national life of Israel and the giving of the covenant.
- Outline:
 - Deliverance (1-18)
 - Covenant and Law (19-24)
 - Tabernacle (25-40)
