Beginning in 2018, The Locals are committed to making Lumberjack Days a low waste event. We'd like to share how this initiative can help your business.

In 2017 we experimented with low waste by offering vendors compostable serving containers. We learned that coordinating this is a complicated job – and we know you want to run your own show.

Enter S.E.E.D. (Stillwater Eco-Empowerment Directive) with grant funds for any business willing to improve their recycling and composting efforts.

Your business is eligible to receive up to \$10,000 in funds to assist you in your effort. You may or may not choose to participate, however it is clear that our visitors do recognize businesses that embrace the spirit of sustainability.

As event coordinators our goal is to pilot a successful low waste event in the coming years. We hope to set an example for other local events and to be supported by the city and county in these efforts.
