We estimated for \$8000 to come from Century Resource results=\$8313.06

\$3000 from Snow Whirl will go to Operating, remaining of Snow Whirl profit will be split between or WG budget and Indoor budget

WG budget and Indoor budget also get 1/3 of Winter Guard Invitational hosted in March (hopefully \$2500 each)

We got a grant from Nine Star for \$1000- have applied that towards purchase of Marimba. We will also get \$1800 from MVEF towards Marimba. We will make up the rest from Operating.

Any accounts that are over \$100 and 60 days past due we will begin a collection process.

We will be applying a sibling discount for winter ensembles more than \$300. They will receive a \$50 discount.
