Cellar Notes:	This variety is truly Mediterranean and perfect for our climate. The grapes are picked when the tannins are ripe, and then fermented at a cool temperature. Maceration was extended to 1 week after the end of natural fermentation, and then pressed and racked to old French oak barrels. The wine was bottled after 12 months barrel maturation.
Tasting Notes:	Delicious, fruity and spicy wine made from the popular Spanish Variety. Soft expressions of plum and cherries, with a delicate hint of spice, and harmonious barrel integration. Top class Grenache is now synonymous with the Piekenierskloof.
