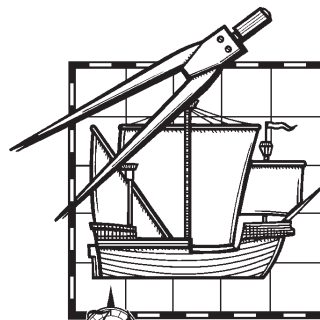

November 19, to dissolve the corporation, disband the Church and distribute the assets to WEBC. This came as a total surprise to us! WEBC was unaware of any of the decisions that would ultimately lead to the current situation. So, what is the current situation? Before I address this question, let me say that this mailing includes the Pine Burr membership of record when the legal matters were considered and approved. So, this article will serve as an update for all of us.

PBBC no longer exists. Pine Burr employees have received a severance package. The money assets are being distributed to various ministries as requested. The parsonage and stock will be transferred to WEBC. Former members who have not joined another congregation are without a church home, but are welcome to join WEBC.

What does 2013 hold? Only God knows. But we are confident "of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ."
