Actor Employment Agreement

Producer's initials required as indicated in Sections 2, 3, 7, 11, 12, 13.

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into as of _____(Date), by and between _____ (hereinafter "Producer"), and Katherine Park Deakin (hereinafter "Actor").

- A. Producer intends to produce a short film hereinafter the "Project" based upon that certain screenplay tentatively entitled "Frequency" hereinafter the "Screenplay").
- B. Producer wishes to utilize the services of Actor in connection with the Project upon the terms and conditions have been contained.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS AGREED AS FOLLOWS

1.) ROLE: Producer hereby engages Actor to render services as such in the role of _____, in the Screenplay "_____".

2.) SALARY: The deferred salary of \$_____ per day, to be paid 30 days before the "Start Date". Actor accepts such agreement upon the terms herein specified. Producer guarantees that it will furnish Actor not less than 3 days employment.

3.) TERM: The term of employment hereunder shall begin on or about _____ (the "Start Date") and continue until _____(the "End Date"). The Term shall include _____ days of rehearsal.

4.) ACTOR'S ADDRESS: All notices which the Producer is required or may desire to give to the Actor may be given either by mailing the same addressed to the Actor at the end of this agreement, or such notice may be given to the Actor personally, either orally or in writing.

5.) ACTOR's TELEPHONE: The Actor must keep the Producer advised as to where the Actor may be reached by telephone without unreasonable delay. The current telephone number is listed at the end of this agreement.

6.) DVD OF PROJECT: Producer will provide Actor with a DVD copy of, or link to download the completed Project within _____ days after the completion of the Project. If the Project is not completed, Producer shall provide Actor with a DVD copy of Actor's scenes within _____ days after the suspension of the Project.

7.) FURNISHING OF WARDROBE: The Actor agrees to furnish all modern wardrobe and apparel reasonably necessary for the portrayal of said role; it being, however, that should so-called "character" or "period" costumes be required, the Producer shall supply the same.

When Actor furnishes any wardrobe, Actor shall receive a responsible cleaning allowance and reimbursement for any soiled or damaged clothes.

8.) NON-UNION PICTURE: Producer makes material representation that it is not a signatory to the Screen Actors Guild collective bargaining agreement or any other union guild agreement.

9.) NAME AND LIKENESS: Producer shall have exclusive right to use and to license the use of Actor's name, photograph, likeness and/or voice by any means in and in connection with the film and the advertising, publicizing, exhibition, and/or other exploitation of the film. Actor's work cannot be used in another project or in another medium unless the Actor agrees to it beforehand.

10.) CREDITS: Actor shall receive a credit under her stage name "**KATHERINE PARK**" at the [*specify* beginning of the film _____ and/or the end credits _____].

11.) TRAVEL EXPENSES: Any right of Actor to transportation and expenses pursuant to this Agreement shall be effective when and only when Actor is required by Producer to render services more than seventy-five (75) miles from Actor's principal place of residence.

Actor shall be reimbursed at the rate of _____ per mile for use of Actor's car to travel to distant locations.

Producer will cover meals, accommodations, and small items such as parking costs.

12.) HEALTH AND SAFETY: Producer will use its best efforts to ensure Actor's health, safety and welfare during the Project. Stunts must be planned, set up, and/or performed by a qualified specialist/double. Qualified first-aid and associated safety personnel are required on set whenever hazardous work is planned.

13.) INSURANCE: Producer warrants that he will maintain public liability insurance to cover Actor during the Project.

14.) FOOD: Producer will provide Actor with food (vegetarian, gluten free option) and refreshments during those periods when Actor's presence is required at the filming of the Project.

15.) EXHIBITION OF PROJECT: Actor agrees not to exhibit the Project in public without the written consent of Producer; provided, however, that the Actor may use portions of the Project in which Actor appears for Actor's demo reel.
