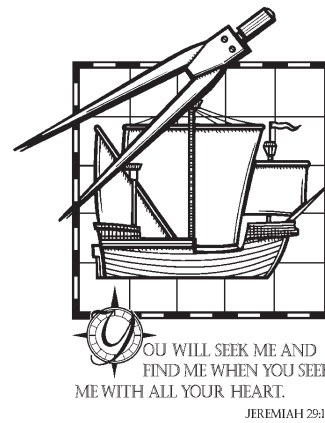

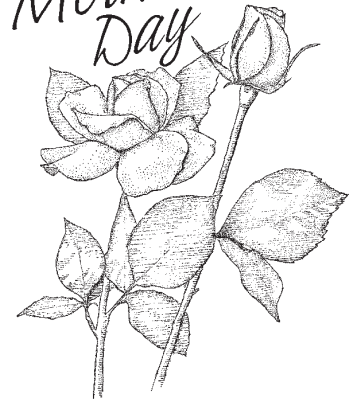

to finalize our itinerary. We plan to revisit the church-start in Maras and encourage them. Last November, we scouted out other villages that have no evangelical work. We will use the blankets to try to establish a Gospel presence in one or more of these villages. Please pray for us! July is Peru's winter! And at thirteen thousand feet, the mountains are super cold! Woolen blankets are life savers in a place where there is only primitive heating! Even our hotel in Ayaviri does not have a heating system, except woolen blankets!! Check out our newly remodeled website, webcbeaumont.org! My prayer has always been that this will be a useful tool at our disposal for promoting the Gospel. Pray for our efforts! If our next fellowship meal is like the one we had last Sunday, I will be forced to fast for a week! Sharing a meal is a treat at WEBC! If you haven't tried it, you're missing a blessing! After all, this is one of the four practices of the first Church! I'll be looking for you along the way. Pray for one another!
