



## O.P.Q.G. Board Meeting Minutes

March 14, 2019

The Meeting was called to order at 9:30 am by President Angie Horne.

### **Old Business:**

Jan Owens took quilts to the Paradise Ridge Quilters meeting. Leftovers went to Honey Run for distribution to Campfire victims. Members should inform Jan Owens if they know of specific needs. Jan is still distributing them to our regular people. Please label quilts with the quilt guild label.

Marge Redding gave an update to the Shadowbrook Outreach project. She is working with patients helping them to stitch 9 patches by hand. The next meeting will be March 27<sup>th</sup> at 2:30 pm (for about 1 hour). She needs volunteers to help. Jeanette Akin and Cheryl Cox volunteered to help.

### **New Business:**

Angie requested that everyone who has keys to Palermo Grange to sign on the key log.

Clara Midwood had inquired at the February meeting if membership fees could be reduced to \$20.

After some discussion Jan Owens moved and Jan Abramson seconded that all members 90 years and over will have free membership. The motion passed unanimously.

Sharon Helton reported that in order to allow Quilt'n Time to put an ad in our Newsletter another page would need to be added at a total cost to us \$124 per year. The cost does not justify making space for ads. Their information is included at the end of our roster for no cost.

Jan Abramson reported that the teachers at Golden Hills Elementary School responded to her request to meet with them about Kids Quilt Camp 2019. She will be meeting with 4<sup>th</sup> grade teachers on Monday – March 18<sup>th</sup> at 10 am.

Initial planning for 2020 Quilt Show has begun. Sharon Helton and Marla Vaughn will be co-chairs.

The show will be November 7-8, 2020. We will ask quilt award sponsors come in and give awards during the quilt show. There will be no other outside judging.

Volunteers are needed to help plan the Guild's 40<sup>th</sup> birthday party to take place at the regular meeting in August. Cheryl Cox volunteered to help.

Jan Owens reported that quilts for the Oroville Rescue Mission need to be of a larger size than our usual community service quilts (60" x 90"). Quilts are not necessarily left at the mission. It was decided that this is not a project to be undertaken by the guild but that any member can make one and be given to Dottie Elliot for distribution. Be sure you inform Jan of any quilts given out for community service that do not go through her.
