- 3 images of work representative of what they would exhibit.
 - *-Image requirements: Jpeg size under 5MB with sRGB color space*
- **Deadline is Monday February 25th, 2019**
- Notification of invite or not invited to the festival by email on Friday March 1st.
- Accepted artists must meet with the FoA Council prior to March 8 for rules and regulations of the event, as well as guidance from the council members.
