What's In a Name?

We call ourselves “Woodland Hills Church of Christ.” The “Woodland Hills” part is because of where we are located. The “Church of Christ” part is because that is what we are. But, be careful. Let us not maintain a name simply because of a human history with that name. It is possible for attachment to a name to produce a denominational mentality. To some extent, I can understand why some have wanted to find a name that left “church of Christ” out of the name. They have commonly been accused by wanting to take Christ out of the church, or of being ashamed of Christ. Perhaps some of them were. Perhaps some just wanted to do church their own way and changing the name was one step in that direction. Or, perhaps they just wanted to get away from a denominational mentality.

Shall we let the Bible determine the name? There are several names that would be biblical. We avoid some of them because of their use as denominational titles by other churches. We do not want a name that would glorify human invention or goals. We do not want a name that would communicate the wrong message. Thus, we have settled with “church of Christ.” This is not because “The Church of Christ” is the denomination to which we belong. It is because we are a church that belongs to Christ.

Survey of Jeremiah

Jeremiah was born into a priestly family (1:1, 18-19; 2:8). He was from Anathoth in the territory belonging to Benjamin (1:1; 11:21-23). He prophesied about 626-586 BC. Thus, he began his prophetic work about one hundred years after the northern nation of Israel had been taken by the Assyrians (722 BC). He lived through the Babylonian invasions and the destruction of Jerusalem (606-586 BC). He prophesied during the reigns of Josiah, Jehoahaz, Jehoiakim, Jehoiachin, and Zedekiah. Baruch wrote down his oracles (36:4). What we have is at least the second edition, since Jehoiakim burned the first one (36:22-32). As is typical of the prophetic books, the material is not in strict chronological order (see, for example, 25:1; 32:1; 45:1). There are some significant sections that are prose, historical material and sections that are records of some of his oracles. Common themes include sin, punishment, and restoration. (The word “repent” occurs about 111 times). At first, Jeremiah urged the people to avert the coming disaster by repenting. Eventually, his message changed and did not allow for averting the disaster but told the people to surrender to Babylon. He predicted that their Babylonian captivity would last seventy years (25:11-12; 29:10).
