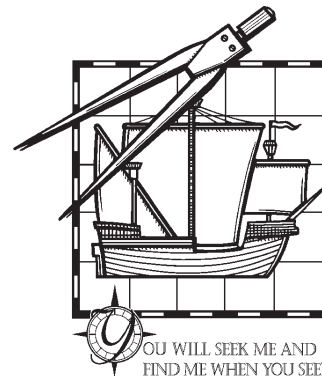

# BIG JIM'S GEMS

"Trust me, trust me!" While you might not have heard those exact words, print and video media would have you believe that this is the mantra of every used car salesperson! Without saying it, manufacturers, distributors, retail outlets and sales personnel are imploring you to "Trust me, trust me!" And the question that begs is, "Why should I?" Good question. 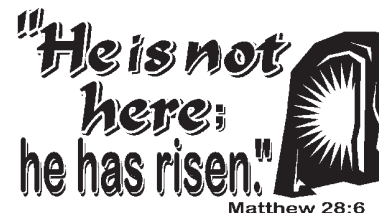

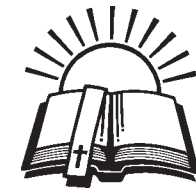
