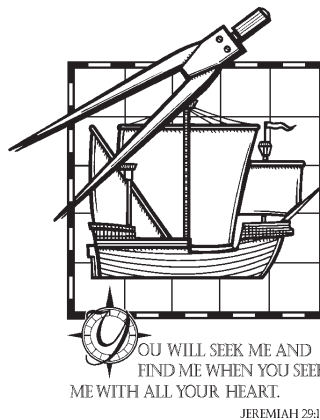

Bless your hearts for all you do for our Lord!

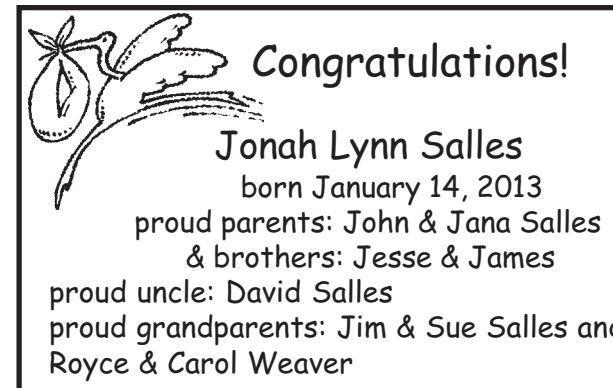
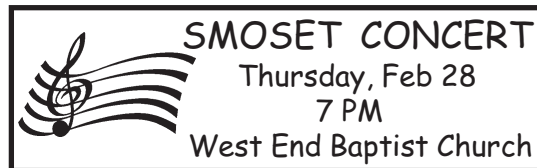
