Harvest & Cellar Notes:	<p>Alphabetical is made as naturally as possible, from vineyards farmed without pesticides or insecticides and with minimal interference in the cellar, only a touch of sulphur added before bottling. Made of just two varietals, it is mostly Roussanne (70%), and Chardonnay (30%).</p> <p>Grapes are crushed and fermented dry in stainless steel, with a small portion ageing in old French oak barrels. Each portion of Alphabetical White is fermented and aged separately, blended and bottled towards the end of the year to settle before release.</p>
Tasting Notes:	<p>A soft, medium-bodied dry white blend with floral notes, ample fruit and minerality and a freshness on the finish that encourages another sip. While it is complex and offers much character, it's as easy as it is interesting.</p>
Aging & Drinking Suggestions:	<p>Best served well chilled. We also particularly enjoy drinking Alphabetical out of tumblers ourselves, but please enjoy however you prefer.</p>
