Saturday Itinerary

- 7:00 AM Report
- Vehicles should park in lot in front of Door 7
  - Leave parking spots in front of Door 8 clear!
- 7:20 AM. Rehearsal
- 9:00 AM Dress/Load/Eat
- Performance attire provided by student
    - **Black** Undershirt/Dress Pants/Belt/Shoes/Socks
  - Road in front of Door 8/9 MUST remain clear
- 10:15 AM Depart for Show Site
- 11:15 AM Arrive at Show Site
- Use bathroom (travel in pairs)
  - Unload equipment/put on black dress shirt
  - Do not wait until the last minute to prepare. Plan ahead!
- 1:00 PM Concert A Class begins
- 12:10 PM Performers/Crew meet at equipment
- 12:24 PM Warm-Up Begins
- 1:00 PM Performance!**
- 1:10 PM Post-Performance
- Load trailer
  - Return dress shirt (required) and change into normal clothes (if desired)
    - Students going out for awards keep their dress shirt on
- 1:45 PM. Eat at concessions/watch other groups
- 2:50 PM Awards**
- 3:30 PM Leave for Mt. Vernon (approx.)
- 4:30 PM Unload/Dismissed from Mt. Vernon (approx.)
- Students dismissed once all equipment has been **properly** put away

Notes:

1. Please eat a quality dinner and get plenty of sleep the night before the contest. Take care of your body!
2. Students may bring money to purchase concessions/merchandise while watching other groups.
3. Make sure you pick up after yourself during meal times. We do not want to set a bad impression.
4. You are representing the Mt. Vernon music department. Conduct yourself in a way that will bring honor to yourself, the band, and the choir.
5. Freshman, use the example of the upperclassmen for your conduct. They know what we expect and I am confident they will do it right.

Suggestions for Parents:

1. Arrive early to get a good seat! It is recommended to sit as high and centered in the stands as possible.
2. It is always a good idea to sit in a group.
3. Please do not shout names of individual students. Treat the group as a whole unit.
4. Be positive about all performing groups. You never know who is hearing your conversation.
5. If traveling in your vehicle with the band, do not merge into the bus/truck convoy. Please follow behind. Spectator parking will be in a different location than bus/truck parking.
