

SCHEDULE OF RATES – January 2018



Lesson Fees

Group (3 or more): \$45.00 each – 1 hr session
Private, regular: \$60.00 each – 45 min. session
Private, short: \$45.00 each – 30 min. mounted session
Semi-private: \$50.00 each – 1 hr session

10% discount monthly package if paid by 1st week of the month.

Lesson fees are due for the month on the first lesson day of that month. Make-up sessions will be scheduled at the convenience of Horseplay instructors if cancellation is given at least 24 hours in advance and due to a documented emergency.

All students will be asked to assist in stable chores: bringing in & turning out the horses/ponies they ride, cleaning & storing tack, feeding & (occasionally) cleaning stalls. (This is not a part of the scheduled lesson time so does not detract from riding.) Grooming and saddling may be included in the lesson time scheduled until students can work safely and independently, applying our standards of safe horsemanship to these skills. (Please ask your instructor if you would like additional details. Parental participation is welcome.) When heavy rains interfere with riding time we will continue with dismounted exercises and instruction and when possible will extend riding time in a subsequent lesson. (Please bring a rain jacket suitable for riding during light rains.)

Boarding: Monthly boarding fee: \$700.00

Board includes: Alfalfa cubes twice daily, cubes and Timothy hay at night. Included in board is a maximum of 22#/day per horse. Horses are fed twice daily. (Horses stalled during the day are also fed lunch). Additional fees will be charged for concentrates and feeding supplements. Stalls are cleaned daily and bedded with dry coffee skins (“parchment”) as available. Should it become necessary to purchase shavings for bedding the additional cost will be added to the board fees. Horses are rotated from stall to paddock or arena turnout 2 hrs per day, 5 days per week. Boarders may turn out their horse on non-staff days with prior approval.

Horseplay expects courtesy for the lesson schedule when boarder’s share the large arena.

Owners who are not available to arrange for services such as shoeing and veterinary care for their horses may schedule these services with Horseplay staff. A charge of \$40/hour will apply with a quarter hour minimum.

Share-boarding (partial lease): Share-boarding is sometimes possible for intermediate and advanced riders and students in a regular lesson program who have reached a sufficient level of practical safety and ability. Suitability of horse/rider combination for share-boarding subject to approval of Horseplay management and/or the horse’s owner, as well as the lesson schedule. Please inquire for schedule of fees. (Students who share-board will often have greater opportunities for competition.) **Students are responsible for the horse in their care when share-boarding (catching, grooming, saddling, feeding, and turning out). It may be required that a parent or supervisor is in attendance.**

Students, family & friends on Horseplay premises who are not in a scheduled lesson are not under supervision. Barn rules must be observed by all owners, share-boarders, families and guests.
