Tuesday June 13, 2017

Call of Roll: All Board Members Present.

Minutes: The May 2017 town board minutes were presented, Bob made a motion to approve, Steve seconded, motion passed.

Treasurers Report: Given.

Public Comment: Louis Husby expressed frustration and asked the Board when they plan on doing some improvements on Crop Road. Gravel washing out, town spending too much money on keeping crushed rock on there. Steve stated it was low priority, but would take another look at it. Louis also mentioned contacting AT&T to get the phone line moved, he is considering getting the DNR involved.

Road Report: Chad is mowing ditches and patching roads.

Land Planning Report: None.

Old Business:

Roads & Bridges: Gene talked to Dustin at the County and sounds like the efforts to convince the DNR to do the Buck's bridge project the "right way" would have a number of conditions on it to even get approved, and not worth the cost involved. They are going forward with the original proposal.

New Business:

Operator's Licenses Applications/Annual Renewal: Kyotes had 1 new applicant, and 6 renewals. Alivia Lensing was the new applicant and background check came back fine. Torch's had 11 renewals. Bob made a motion to approve, Steve seconded, motion passed.

ATV Riders Association Request: A member was present from the area ATV Riders Association. They are looking to add a new trail/crossing in the Knapp area (Hwy K to 250th). The Board requested they get approval from the land owners/residents and come back in July for approval.

County/UW Extension Presentation Broadband Access: Bob Colson from the County was present to inform the Board about a survey going out to area residents about the type of internet/broadband service they have. The hope is to get a better picture of what people have, and how to improve access in many areas.

Trainor Reclamation Concerns: Yvonne Trainor was present to express concerns they are having with the County regarding the reclamation process for the Cotts Quarry they purchased in 2003. Problems with erosion, wash outs etc... Trainor's have gone to the County and have gotten nowhere. They are asking the Board for help, be another voice. Gene said he will personally take a look at the issues with another Board member and share what they see, and what could be done with the County.

Bills: Bob made a motion to approve the June bills, Steve seconded, motion passed.
