

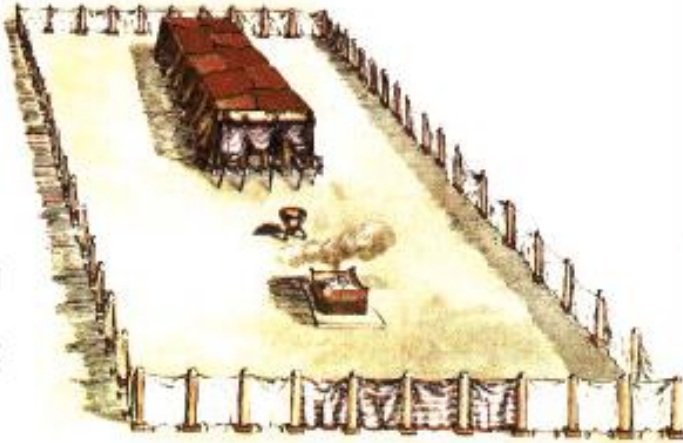

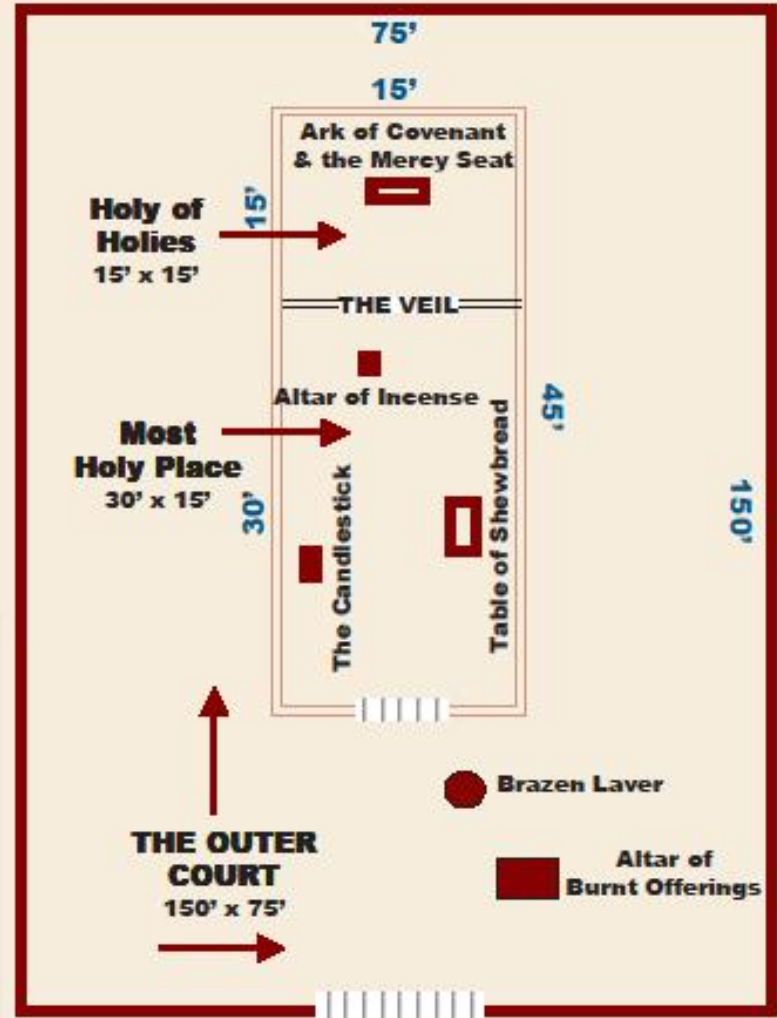


The Diagram of the Tabernacle



**TABERNACLE
DIMENSIONS**

- Outer Court - 150' x 75'
- Tabernacle - 45' x 15'
- Most Holy Place - 30' x 15'
- Holy of Holies - 15' x 15'

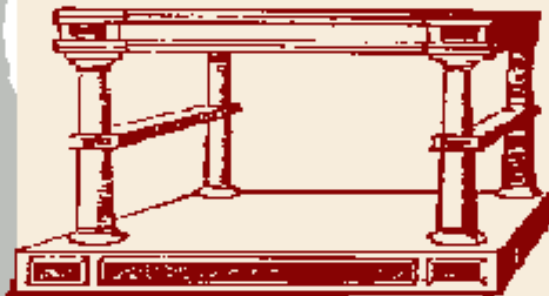


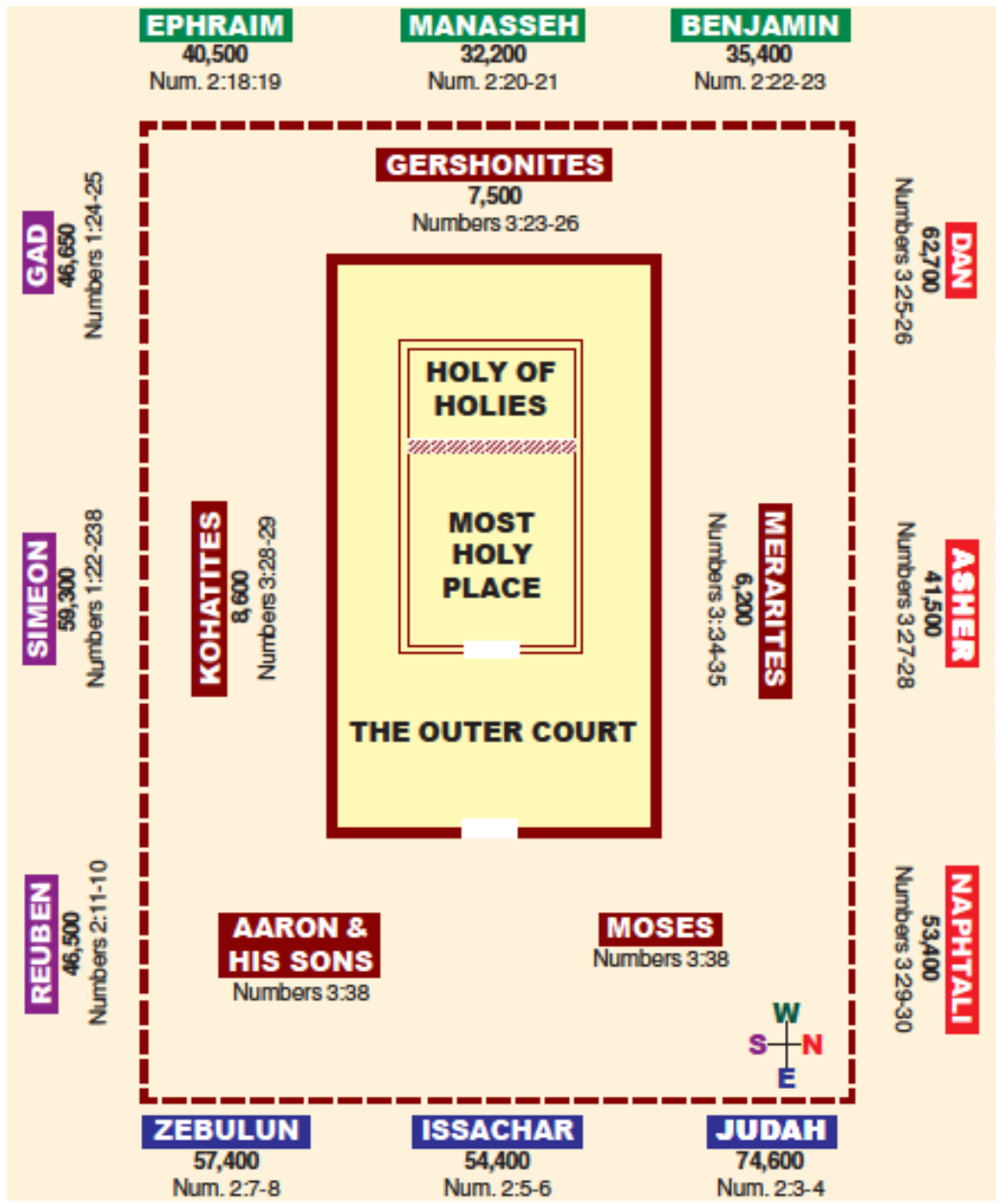

Encampments Around the Tabernacle



“Everyone of the children of Israel shall camp by his own standard beside the emblems of his father’s house; they shall camp some distance from the tabernacle of meeting.” Numbers 2:2

It is estimated that the Israelite camp covered about SEVEN SQUARE MILES



The Garments for Priests

- ❑ Who are the priests? Ex 28:1,43; Num 18:1-7
 - ❑ Sons of Aaron: Nadab, Abihu, Eleazar, and Ithamar
 - ❑ All Levites were not priests Num 16-17
- ❑ Make garments for them exactly as instructed using gold, blue, purple, and scarlet.
- ❑ The High Priests garment is described in most detail





The Garments for Priests

- ❑ Priests as mediators between God and Israel
 - ❑ Sacrificing before law: Cain/Abel, Abraham, Job
 - ❑ Law of Moses: Priests set apart for this work
 - ❑ Teach Israel all the statutes (Lev 10:10-11; Mal 2:7)
 - ❑ Keep the sanctuary and altar
 - ❑ Make intercession (Heb 7:25)





The Garments for Priests

High priest's layered garments

Undergarment: boxer shorts Ex 28:42-43

Tunic/coat Ex 28:39

Robe (blue) of the ephod Ex 28:31-35

Ephod Ex 28:6-14

Breastplate Ex 28:15-30

Turban and sash Ex 28:36-40







Rules for Sacrifices

Burnt offerings

Lev 1:3-17

Lay hands on it and kill it

Blood sprinkled on and about altar

Fire burning through the night

Ashes removed from camp

Bulls, sheep, goats, doves, pigeons

Complete dedication and atonement **Lev 16:24**





Rules for Sacrifices

- Meal (grain) offering Lev 2:1-16
 - Alone or accompanying other sacrifice
 - Grain and drink offering Num 15:1-16
 - Specific portions specified
 - Raw, baked, fried, pan-fried, roasted
 - Frankincense
 - No yeast or honey
 - Burnt upon altar, but mainly went to priests





Rules for Sacrifices

Peace offering “shelem”

Lev 3:1-17

Thanksgiving

Vow

Freewill/voluntary

All is right (or supplication) between the worshipper and God





Rules for Sacrifices

- Combination of sacrifices (order specified)**
 - Sin offering (forgiveness)**
 - Burnt offering (complete dedication)**
 - Peace offering (ensuing fellowship God/man)**





Rules for Sacrifices

Sin offering

Lev 4 – 5:13

Whole congregation

Priest

Ruler

Other individual

To remove guilt, to remove wrath of God and restore favor





Rules for Sacrifices

Sin offerings (continued)

Trespass offerings

Lev 5:14-6:7

Specific kind of sin offering

Involves depriving either God or man of something deserved.

Day of Atonement - Unknown sins

Sins of omission - Failures to obey

Law of Restitution – 20% additional to original value

Presumptuous sin – deliberate, willful, arrogantly

No sacrifice

Nu 15:30-31
